Project Details

BTP has been appointed by the Diocese of Shrewsbury to design and deliver a new Church Hall and apartments.

The project is due to start on site and will involve demolishing the existing church hall and constructing a new purpose built hall in its place. The project will also deliver two apartments in a two storey block on part of the car park between the presbytery and church.

- New building to be low energy BREAM excellent.
- Hall will be a multi-functional space to attract a variety of community groups.
- Project replaces a temporary 1930s structure which was uneconomical and had no sustainable future.
- Hall will create a striking landmark to main route into Manchester.
